The first mile and a half is a gradual uphill walk up Welton Dale. We then pick up the High Hunsley Circuit followed by a long slow downhill with good views over the Humber estuary. The last section is along a quiet road with some ups and downs but all quite gentle (and plenty of seats!).

Leaving North Newbald by Beverley Road the route passes through Swin Dale following part of the Wolds Way to Littlewood Road and Whin Lane, returning to Newbald via Trundle Gate, hopefully giving good views over the Vale of York.



Assemble for a 10:00am start; those stopping for optional lunch can park at the Gnu Inn. Those not stopping for lunch please park on the streets around The Green or on Eastgate as the car park is not that large and room need to be left for any other customers.
