Walkers 10th September, 10:00am, North Newbald

The walk planned for Thursday 10th September is at North Newbald, YO43 4SA. It will be a 6 mile, clockwise, circular walk with an elevation gain of 120m. Leaving North Newbald by Beverley Road the route passes through Swin Dale following part of the Wolds Way to Littlewood Road and Whin Lane, returning to Newbald via Trundle Gate, hopefully giving good views over the Vale of York.
